COVID-19 – AGC closure

Message from the President

Hi All,

Times are changing and given the escalation to level 4 of the Covid-19 alert scale, the Auckland Gliding Club must announce the closure of the club's operations and facilities for the near future.

From the Government:

The lockdown starts at 11:59pm on Wednesday 25th March. From this point on, unless you are providing an essential service or going to the supermarket or getting a bit of brisk exercise (at a distance from others), you must self-isolate at home.

We will continue to collaborate with the Gliding NZ leadership and monitor the Governments announcements through this period. I anticipate an update prior the proposed end of the lockdown on the 23rd April. Any changes to the closure status in the interim will be communicated by the AGC committee.

Please be considerate of social isolation principles and keep in mind many of our members are represented in the most at-risk groups. If there's something you want to do, questions to ask or something to contribute just reach out to one of the committee members.
