GNZ First Competition Award

Background:

The Gliding New Zealand (GNZ) Sailplane Racing Committee and Executive recognize that gliding competitions can be particularly demanding for first-time competitors. This award has been developed to encourage and support early cross-country pilots in their first competition.

Award:

For all recipients, GNZ will defray the cost of entry into a GNZ Sanctioned contest (Regionals, Club or Multi-Class Nationals) of their preference, noting that the Sports Class if offered is an ideal class for first time competitors. GNZ will contribute \$100 towards competition launch fees.

Protocol:

- Pilots follow the normal procedure to claim FAI Silver Distance by completing a GNZ OPS 04 form and returning it (with supporting evidence) to the GNZ Awards Officer.
- Successful FAI Silver Distance claimants will receive an award letter from the GNZ Awards Officer in conjunction with recognition of the distance flight. The Awards Officer will also send a copy of this letter to the GNZ Treasurer.
- After their chosen competition, awardees should make their claim to the GNZ Treasurer, by providing a copy of an invoice from the competition organisers showing the cost of their launches and confirmation of payment.

Conditions:

- 1. Eligibility requirements at the time of uptake, awardees must:
 - a. Not have previously flown in gliding competitions,
 - b. Be a Flying Member of GNZ affiliated club and be a NZ resident (ie not for visiting pilots),
 - c. Fulfill entry conditions to a GNZ Sanctioned Contest as outlined in the GNZ Competition rules.
- 2. Awardees must uptake the award within 24 months of receipt, after which automatic forfeit will occur.
- 3. GNZ reserves the right to terminate, withhold, or amend this award at any stage.
