Craig then took me up to get his Back seater rating signed off. As there were no more eager pilots we packed away - only to have a few stragglers arrive as we put the planes to bed. As the conditions were not great we collectively decided to leave them be in the hangar and retired for some cold ones. Nice to be back up and flying even though the weather was not playing nicely - it is winter after all.
