For those who use the service Metflight, it will be retired at the end of the month. It is being replaced by gopreflight.co.nz.

This new service is vastly superior to the old Metflight, with all you need for free. For just \$8.50 month more you can get a few more advanced goodies. Just select the briefing area required and push OK. All NOTAMS will be displayed and can be filtered by en-route, or aerodromes. All Aerodrome forecasts are shown but you'll need to

brush up on your abbreviations if used to using the plain language option. Fortunately, the help menu (under the three horizontal bars in the top left-hand corner) has links to the weather card with all the abbreviations listed. If you're still struggling, you can click on the Meteorology for PPL, CPL & ATPL link and then download the PPL ebook. This has full details of how to interpret the information, plus a whole lot more. It's worth a read in any case.

Go preflight is still being worked on to provide the best service possible and is one of the tools we should all use in future.
