Steve Wallace took us through 75 years of history with a grand slide show on the big screen. A yummy buffet dinner was enjoyed by all. Then we heard some amazing stories about amazing glider pilots told by amazing people. The OGC hauled in the trophies with Phil Plane winning the Angus Rose Bowl for outstanding services to the sport. New Youth Glide President Felix Harper received the Air New Zealand XC Trophy for flights in the South Island last season. John Smith won the Air NZ Soaring Award for the most significant improvement in their personal standard of flying. Dan McComack accepted the Buckland Soaring Award for Kelvyn Flavell. Rod Stuart won the friendship cup for outstanding contribution to the gliding movement. Nigel Davy was appointed our new GNZ President. And to top it off the Americas Cup was in the same room as us! What a grand night!
