Ross MacIntyre

1933 - 2025



It is with great sadness that I report the passing of Ross MacIntyre.

Ross died peacefully on the 28th November in Bittsham, near Cambridge in the UK.

He was 92.

Many of you will know the name; he has been an honorary life member of our club for the last 30 years.

Ross was CFI when I joined and was one of many of our instructors that taught me to fly. At that time he owned a very nice LS3 (GJL as I recall) that he shared with Peter for seven years. He played a key role in Gliding both in New Zealand and on the world stage.

He joined the Wellington Gliding club in 1959. He became the Press Officer for GNZ in 1963 and wrote many articles to lift the profile of gliding in NZ. In 1970 he became the Awards Officer and continued in that role until he left NZ in 1992 to return to Britain. The Angus Rose Bowl was awarded to Ross in 1984. As awards officer he made many suggestions to the improvement of the code nearly all of which were accepted.

Once back in the UK he became NZ's representative at the FAI and continued to play a key role in the development of the Sporting Code. Among his many contributions was guiding the changes necessary to usher in the introduction of GPS technologies. In 1999 he became chairperson of the Sporting Code Committee.

When the FAI met in Switzerland in 2010 they chose to award Gliding's highest award, the Lilienthal Medal, to Ross.

Our condolences to his wife, Marion and sons Craig, Andrew and Doug.


