Previous satisfactory experience as an Official Observer for FAI badges or National Records where flight recorders were used is required before appointment may be made as a Senior Official Observer. Applications for appointment as a Senior Official Observer must be accompanied by a written description of the applicant's recent experience as an Official Observer.
